

What's a FoWCM anyway?

During 2021 a group of long-time WollCon students decided to form the Friends of WollCon Community Music (FoWCM for short); an unincorporated association designed to support community music programmes and associated activities in the Illawarra region; including the community music programmes offered by the Wollongong Conservatorium of Music (WollCon). FoWCM has been registered as a charity with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission.

FoWCM seeks out opportunities to source funds that can be used to facilitate performances and activities by local amateur community music ensembles. FoWCM will provide funds to help stage inclusive community music events; and acquire suitable equipment and resources which can be made available to ensembles; choirs and bands.

Our activities in 2022

During its first year of operation FoWCM has supported a number of the events staged by WollCon to mark its 50^{th} year of operations, including:-

- Collecting donations at **Celebrating Our Community Musicians** concert at Wollongong City Gallery, April 2, and again, at the **Celebrating Jazz at WollCon** concert at Wollongong Town Hall, April 9.
- Supporting WollCon's successful bid for Create NSW funding to bring **Hot Potato Band** as Artist-In-Residence during 2022.
- Contributing funds (\$2000) to WollCon's 50th Anniversary appeal conducted under Create NSW's PlusOne Funding mechanism; thus helping raise some \$32,000 for WollCon programmes during 2022.
- Presenting a charity fund-raiser as the Welcome to Honk!Oz 2022 event at The Servo, Port Kembla on 14th July. \$704 was raised on the night and donated to the NSW Floods Appeal.

Other activities pursued by FoWCM this year have included:-

- Contributing funds to help establish the Minor Swing Guitar Ensemble.
- Successfully securing Wollongong City Council Small Cultural Grant of \$2500 to stage a Performance Workshop for the Five Islands String Orchestra during early 2023.
- Securing of WCC grants to support performances by The Con Artists and the WollCon Community Orchestra during 2022-23.
